

Eyam Half Marathon - 2012

| Time / Date | Race will begin at 10:30 am on Sunday 20 th May, 2012 |
| Location | The small Peak District village of Eyam, situated on the B6521 between the A625 and A623. |
| Parking | Due to building development in the village, parking will be curtailed this year. The race will be limited to 500 applicants with no late entrants on the day of the race. You will be directed to appropriate car parking areas on entering the village. Please note: No street parking will be allowed. |
| Changing Facilities | The following changing facilities are available:- <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ladies at the Village Club• Gents at the Village School. Unfortunately, no shower facilities are available at either of these locations. |
| Toilets | Public toilets can be found in the village car park, next to the official race car parking. |
| Start / Finish | The race will start and finish in the village square, approximately 0.75 mile from the car parking. |
| First Aid | First Aid facilities can be found by the start/finish line in the village square. |
| Registration | No pre-registration will be necessary. |
| Water / Sponges | Buxton water and wet sponges will be available at regular locations on the course. |
| Communication | On course communication will be supplied by RAYNET. |
| Support vehicle | A community bus will follow the race, and be available to any retirees. |
| Results | Results will be posted at race HQ in the village square, and will also be available on the internet at www.eyamhalfmarathon.org.uk . PLEASE WEAR YOUR RACE NUMBER ON THE FRONT OF YOUR SHIRT. FAILURE TO DO SO MIGHT RESULT IN YOU NOT BEING GIVEN A TIME |
| Presentation | 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd prizes (male and female) prizes will be presented as soon as is practical after the race. Please note that other prizes will be posted out after the event. |
| Fun Run | Fun Run entries will take place at George Siddall's, the local butchers shop behind the main race start and finish line. The Fun Run will commence approximately 15-20 minutes after the main race has begun. The race is run on the road, over a distance of approximately 1.3 miles. Please note: The race will not be a timed event, and runners take part at their own risk. |
| Definitions | Local individual: A non-affiliated runner, living within the Eyam electoral boundary. Local team: Non-affiliated runners, all of whom reside within a 5 mile radius of the Eyam church. |
