

Eyam Half Marathon - 2015


Information Sheet

Time / Date	Race will begin at 10:30 am on Sunday 17 th May, 2015
Location	The small Peak District village of Eyam, situated on the B6521 between the A625 and A623.
Parking	Parking in the village is limited. The race will be restricted to 500 runners, with no entrants being accepted on the day of the race. You will be directed to appropriate car parking areas on entering the village. No street parking will be allowed.
Changing Facilities	The following changing facilities are available - storage of kit is at owners risk:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ladies at the Mechanics Institute (Village Club) opposite the Church • Gents at the Village School – 50 metres east of the Church. Unfortunately, no shower facilities are available at either of these locations.
Toilets	Public toilets can be found in the village car park, next to the official race car parking. Start/finish line toilets will be available in the Miners Arms car park.
Start / Finish	The race will start and finish in the village square, approximately 0.75 mile from the car parking.
First Aid	First Aid facilities can be found by the start/finish line in the village square and in Abney Village. There will also be a Mobile Unit on the course.
Registration	No pre-registration will be necessary.
Audio Players	We recommend that runners do not use MP3 players, as this might invalidate insurance cover.
Refunds	We cannot provide refunds or transfer/defer entries should you decide not to participate.
Water	Water will be available at regular locations on the course.
Communication	On course communication will be supplied by RAYNET.
Support vehicle	A community bus will follow the race, and be available to any retirees.
Results	Results will be posted at race HQ in the village square, and will also be available on the internet at www.eyamhalfmarathon.org.uk . PLEASE WEAR YOUR RACE NUMBER ON THE FRONT OF YOUR SHIRT. FAILURE TO DO SO MIGHT RESULT IN YOU NOT BEING GIVEN A TIME
Presentation	All monetary prizes will be posted out after the race, when results have been verified.
Fun Run	Fun Run entries will take place in the Miners Arms public house. The Fun Run will commence approximately 15-20 minutes after the main race has begun. The race is run on the road, over a distance of approximately 1.3 miles. Please note: The Fun Run is not a timed event, and participants take part at their own risk and with parent/guardian's consent.
Definitions	Local individual: A non-affiliated runner, living within the Eyam electoral parish boundary.
Lining Up at Start	Please line up at the start with consideration for faster runners: 1.20/30 hr at the front; 1.40/50 hr in the middle; 2.00 hr towards the rear

Please note: By entering the Eyam Half Marathon, you agree that the organisers shall not be liable for any accidents, injury, loss or damage howsoever caused, or for any property lost either on the course or at any of the race facilities.
